About the Archives

On 1 June 2008 Frederikshavn Municipality founded the City Archives of Frederikshavn.

The Archives contain municipal archives from the present-day Frederikshavn Municipality, as well as the former Frederikshavn, Skagen and Sæby Municipalities, including the rural districts that disappeared during the municipal reform of 1970.

Many documents that were sent to the State Archives in Viborg have now been returned to us. You will find a record of these documents on the City Archives' homepage
